fficials and staff at Discovery Charter gave The Hamstra Group top grades for its construction of a new facility for the school.

After initial contact in December 2015, a contract was in place by January 2016, with construction completion set for the end of the school's Christmas break in January 2017. But Hamstra's team "got its book report in early" so to speak. The new Discovery Charter facility was able to open early to students and staff in November 2016.

Located in Porter, Indiana, Discovery Charter currently

serves 518 students. A growing school, it needed more room, as well as upgrades to existing spaces. The project called for additional classrooms, a brand new gymnasium (the school had been without one prior to this project), a new kitchen, and other amenities. The expansive gym does double duty as a lunch room.

The structure is a Varco Pruden pre-engineered steel building with colored standing seam

roof, cultured stone wainscot, and a chair lift to accommodate the different floor heights from the new building to the old building. The parking lot was also expanded.

"We were very impressed with The Hamstra Group's enthusiasm and efficiency," said Ernesto Martinez, the school's principal. "The team work was amazing and we really felt like the company cared about our needs."

Team work is a key component of Hamstra's approach to every project, according to project manager Curt Albertson.



"When we take on a project, we try to exceed expectations," Albertson explained. "Our Hamstra team had an exceptional crew on this




job (see the list of team members on page 4) that wanted to make sure students, staff, and management would love the new facilities."
